three people entered the U.S. on tourist visas with their families and were later granted asylum.

On the Canadian border, Ahmed Ressay was caught by border agents in December 1999 after he tried to enter the United States at Port Angeles, Washington, with bomb components in the trunk of his car. It was later determined Ressay planned to attack the Los Angeles airport during the millennium.

"The evidence shows that if we are going to talk about terrorism, there is actually good reason to think more carefully about the U.S.'s northern border than the U.S.'s southern border," said Emily Gilbert, a terrorism expert and director of the Canadian studies program at the University of Toronto.

The U.S.-Canadian border is over 5,500 miles (8,900 kilometers) long, more than 2½ times the length of the U.S. border with Mexico, and is crossed by numerous roads and railroad tracks, with many wide-open stretches. In Richford, the border cuts through farm fields and forests with occasional granite markers in the ground.

Worries about terrorists crossing from Canada have been reduced by the close cooperation between the two countries, and security has been tightened since 9/11. Hundreds more Border Patrol agents are stationed along the border (authorities won't disclose the total), surveillance has been enhanced with such things as electronic sensors and helicopters, and those trying to cross the border must show a passport or certain other documents, none of which were required before Sept. 11, 2001.

In the Richford incident, Walid Kabbani was seized at the border, and his two accomplices in the van were arrested at a local hotel the morning after. U.S. authorities said the three men, Lebanese-born Canadians from Montreal, were members of an extremist group responsible for the 1982 assassination of Lebanese President-elect Bashir Gemayel.

Federal officials were never able to say for sure what their intended target was. All three were convicted or pleaded guilty to explosives and immigration violations and went to prison, getting out in the 1990s.

Terrorism was the last thing on Jewett's mind when he became police chief in the border town, which has around 2,300 people and is about 2,000 miles from the Mexican border. He said the current debate about a border wall with Mexico and the recent 35-day government shutdown it provoked has gone too far.

"I do also understand we need some protections on our borders. And I just don't know what it is," Jewett said. "It's hard."

A big question is whether Digital First could get significant votes from other shareholders, said Rick Edmonds, media business analyst at the Poynter Institute. And there may be other twists and turns to come. There is industry speculation that Gannett, which also owns the Arizona Republic, Detroit Free Press and Indianapolis Star, may try to combine with another newspaper publisher or turn around and try to buy parts of Digital First.

named in the reports, the journalists and two men who were quoted saying they witnessed some of the alleged misbehavior.

Most of the women who spoke about were fellow Green Party members. Four filed criminal complaints for sexual harassment. A nine-month judicial investigation ended without charges, with prosecutors saying the statute of limitations had expired.

Baupin was not in court Monday and doesn't plan to attend the trial. Defense lawyers requested an order forcing him to appear, but the judge said that as the plaintiff Baupin had the right not to be there.

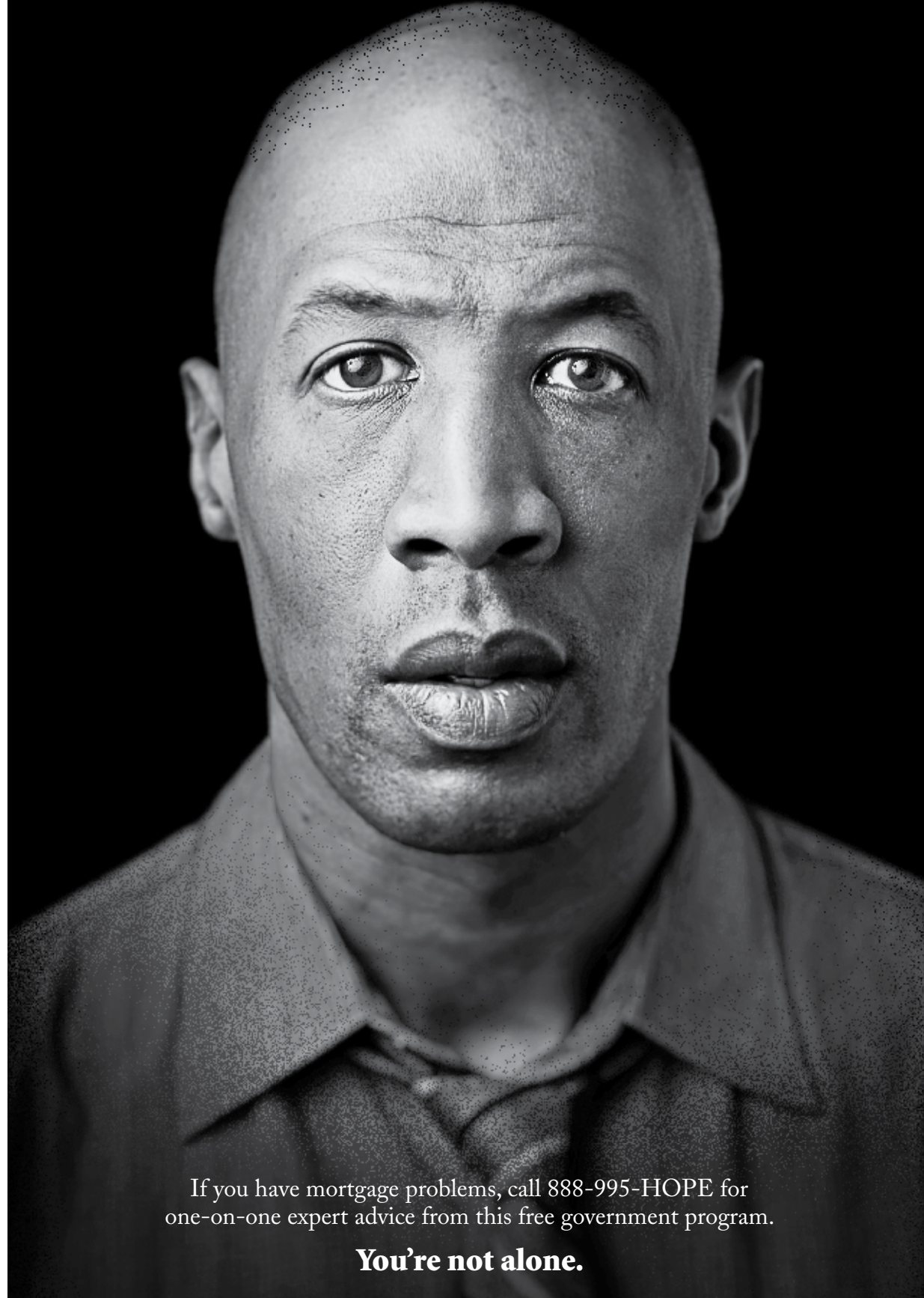
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nized Lee-Jackson Day, which honors Confederate generals Robert E. Lee and Stonewall Jackson.

Virginia is still healing from the racial wounds inflicted in August 2017, when white supremacists marched on Charlottesville to protest the removal of a statue of Lee. Many of the mostly white men who converged on the city chanting racist slogans and burning torches were about the same age that Northam would've been as a student at Eastern Virginia Medical School.

Northam's age belies the assumption that their actions reflected the tenor and tone of the era. In 1984 when the photograph was included in Northam's yearbook page, civil rights activist Jesse Jackson was running for president. Pioneering black entertainer Bill Cosby was the star of one of America's most popular television shows. African-Americans were climbing the nation's social, professional, political and economic ladders at unprecedented speed.

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
