when they change names. Small business owners who rely on their own creativity can find that what sounds right to them doesn't make sense to potential customers.

When Jaime Masters launched her skin care products company in 2007, she named it Trinite Organiques, using the French words for the Trinity and organics. She had recently suffered three losses including the death of her father, and "Trinity represented the three losses, the three ingredients that were in every product at the time and my faith which got me through those losses," says Masters, who lives in Kansas City, Kansas, and sells her products online and at events.

But the name fell flat with the public.

"There's nothing wrong with a name having a personal meaning behind it but when no one can spell it or pronounce it and it's too long you have a major problem," Masters says.

After several years of struggling, Masters put together a focus group, using people she knew and some she didn't know, and asked their opinion about an entirely different name, 826 & Co., based on her daughter's birth date. This brand, launched two years ago, is succeeding.

flashlights, bedding and battery-operated radios and cellphone chargers.

Evacuation planning is harder to do in advance because of the unpredictability of a storm's path. As Hurricane Irma approached southeastern Florida in 2017, some residents who evacuated to Tampa in expectation the western coast of the state would be spared had to hurriedly move further north when the storm's course changed. But once owners know where their staffers will be sheltered, they should have a complete list of locations.

Businesses in inland places rarely hit by hurricanes should do at least basic planning. As Irma moved north, it hit cities like Atlanta, hundreds of miles away from the ocean.

Disaster planning can be highly detailed, and owners may not realize they're forgetting important aspects of protecting their companies. A number of online disaster prep resources are available from federal and state government agencies, and some include checklists that will help owners decide what they need to do.

tions, because employers sometimes set plans to automatically increase savings rates unless workers opt out of it.

It didn't hurt that stock prices were storming higher early this year, as worries about a possible recession receded, and the S&P 500 had its best first quarter since "Titanic" was pulling in moviegoers in 1998.

Those gains, plus workers' additional contributions, meant the average 401(k) account balance stood at \$103,700 at the end of March, according to Fidelity. That's up from \$95,600 at the start of the year and \$102,900 a year ago.

Balances for individual retirement accounts and 403(b) accounts had similar gains, up to averages of \$107,100 and \$85,800, respectively.

Retirement experts have long asked workers to stay the course when it comes to their savings. The stock market tends to have steep drops of 20% or more every six or seven years, and temptation can be high in such moments to sell out of stocks to protect whatever's left in the nest egg.

mediate goods flow back and forth across the border to optimize advantages in workforce or infrastructure, and it is typical for supply chains of numerous industries such as automotive and medical device production to cross the border multiple times during the manufacturing process. Slowing at the border disrupts this pattern, causing harm to companies in both nations.

The economies of the United States and Mexico are inextricably intertwined to the benefit of both nations. In fact, facilitating integration would lead to greater growth on both sides of the border. By contrast, delays at the border can cause losses of billions of dollars in gross product, and solving these problems is in the mutual interest of the US and Mexico. The time is now!
