8. That Defendant NAMBC has clouded Plaintiff's title and encumbered the property without any right to do so.

9. That Defendant NAMBC has recorded fraudulent documents against the title of Plaintiff's property in Kings County (NY) Recorder's Office thereby making the Plaintiff's title unmarketable.

10. Defendant NAMBC's encumbering and clouding the title of the Subject Property has made it unmarketable. **However, after fighting for 3+ years, in February 2020, Plaintiff secured a trial loan modification from the Lender, but the matter regarding title still exists. (Loan Modification attached hereto as Exhibit "A").** Nevertheless, the Lender requested that Plaintiff have title quieted in her favor within 90 days from the date of signing the trial loan modification in order to receive a permanent loan modification. It is only because of COVID-19 and the delays it caused with the courts and day-to-day business, that her loss mitigation file has not been closed. This matter is causing Plaintiff so many problems, she is hanging on by a thread. But she keeps making payments and is looking forward to securing a permanent modification and putting this all behind her.

11. Plaintiff is a Pro Per litigant and has done everything this Honorable Court has requested of her. She attempted service via mail, certified mail and publication in 2 separate newspapers in Harris County, the County of Defendant's last known address. (Both publications attached as Exhib-

it "B"). After doing all of this, Plaintiff thought she would be granted a Default Judgment so that she could clear title as per her Lender's request. But, much to her dismay, her request was denied. Therefore she submits her amended petition with hopes that this court rules in her favor.

PRAYER

Plaintiff hereby prays that this Honorable Court:

1. Issue an order/judgment quieting title against Defendant NAMBC, and in favor of Plaintiff decreeing and declaring that the Property is owned and possessed by Plaintiff TARASMATTI NAGESAR; and

2. Issue and order/judgment declaring that any and all documentation recorded by Defendant NORTHWEST ALLIANCE MORTGAGE BANKING CORP., in Kings County Recorder's Office against the Subject Property, be deemed fraudulent, invalid and vacated;

"It was stated in no uncertain terms," Gokal said in a video interview from his Houston attorney's office Tuesday. "The conversation specifically was, as I was being told I did the wrong things, 'Well, you didn't give it out equitably.' I asked him, 'Equitably? What do you mean equitably? Are you saying there's too many Indian names in the group?' He looks at me and says, 'Exactly.'"

The department charged him with misdemeanor theft, which a judge dismissed, and reported him to the state's medical licensing board. County officials still presented the theft case to the grand jury, however, a process that took six months before the jury finally cleared him.

The medical licensing board had cleared him long before then, and he was able to resume practicing emergency medicine at Houston-area hospitals.

A spokesman for the Harris County District Attorney's Office referred requests for a response to the county attorney's office, which did not immediately return a message.

try and other parts of the economy.

The Transportation Department approved the agreement, with certain conditions, in January during the final days of the Trump administration. The airlines gave up some takeoff and landing slots at John F. Kennedy International Airport in New York and Washington Reagan National Airport outside Washington, and they agreed not to cooperate on setting prices.

"Instead of suing now, the (Justice Department) should have waited and monitored and held us accountable to the benefits that we said this would deliver," JetBlue CEO Robin Hayes said in an interview.

Hayes disputed the Justice Department's belief that the deal will stop his airline from competing against American outside the Northeast. He noted that JetBlue this year started flying from New York to London and between Miami and Los Angeles, important routes for American.

Despite the green light from the Transportation Department, antitrust lawyers at the Justice Department began examining the deal more closely this spring and requested interviews and documents from the airlines, according to an airline lawyer involved in the case.

In the last three weeks it became apparent that the Justice Department was likely to file a lawsuit, said the attorney, who spoke on condition of anonymity because discussions with the regulators were private.

The airlines call their partnership the Northeast Alliance or NEA. It lets American and JetBlue sell seats on each other's flights and give customers reciprocal benefits in the separate frequent-flyer programs.

American and JetBlue argue that the deal is pro-consumer by making their combination a stronger competitor in the Northeast. Together, the airlines say, they controlled 16% of the region's air-travel market before the partnership, and that has grown to 24%.

The airlines argue that the Justice Department has no evidence that their agreement is leading to higher fares. Air-travel prices have been hurt by the pandemic, which continues to cut into travel demand and push fares lower.

American and JetBlue argue that nothing in their deal controls pricing, and that each airline will continue to set its own fares.

Southwest Airlines and Spirit Airlines filed formal complaints against the American-JetBlue alliance, however, arguing that — along with a similar deal on the West Coast between American and Alaska Airlines — it will make American too big.

The Justice Department lawsuit was filed in federal district court in Massachusetts. The department was joined by the attorneys general of California, Massachusetts, Florida, Pennsylvania, Virginia, Arizona and the District of Columbia.
